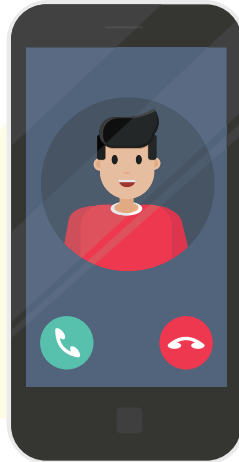


DISTRACTED DRIVING IS

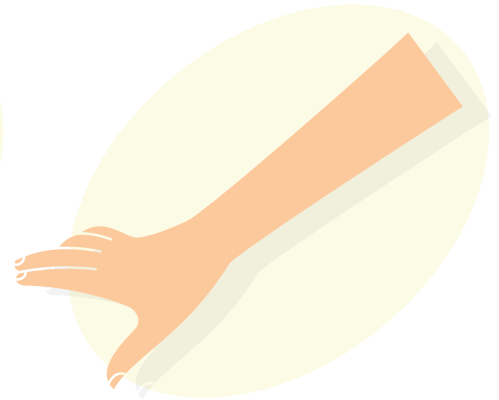
taking your eyes off the road, your hands off the wheel, or your mind off driving. Texting while driving is **ILLEGAL**, even at a stoplight, in North Dakota.



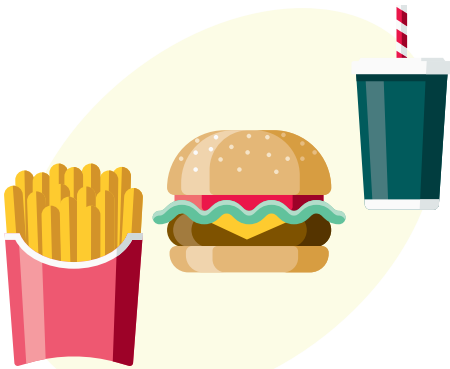
