North Dakota's Driving Skills for Success (DSFS) is a free, one-day Vision Zero program designed to give teen drivers (ages 14–18 with a valid permit or license) a chance to build real-world, safe-driving habits in a controlled environment.

The North Dakota Safety Council's Alive at 25 program is an interactive defensive-driving course specifically designed for young drivers. It focuses on attitude, behavior, judgment, and decision-making. Alive at 25 helps young drivers understand risks like speed, impairment, fatigue, distraction, and peer pressure and encourages personal responsibility for safe driving behavior.

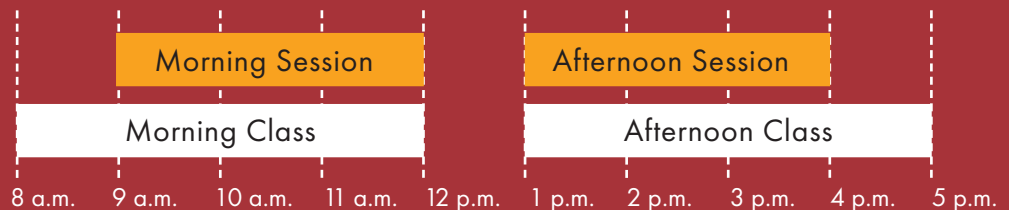
FREE EVENT
